AMENDED APPLICATION

COMES NOW MANZANO OIL CORPORATION, through its undersigned attorneys, and hereby makes application for an order approving an unorthodox well location, and in support thereof states:


1. Applicant is the operator of the SW/4 SW/4 of Section 14, Township 10 South, Range 37 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico on which it proposes to drill its Manzano S.V. Sundown State No. 1 Well as a wildcat well in the Devonian formation, 477 feet from the South line and 191 feet from the West line in Unit M of said Section 14.
2. Applicant seeks an exception to Division's well location requirements to permit the drilling of said well in the Devonian formation at the above-described location.
3. A standard 40-acre spacing and proration unit comprised of the SW/4 SW/4 of said Section 14 should be dedicated to the well.
4. Approval of this application will afford Applicant the opportunity to produce its just and equitable share of the gas in the Devonian formation and will otherwise be in the best interest of the conservation, the protection of correlative rights and the prevention

of waste.

WHEREFORE, Applicant requests that this matter be set for hearing before a duly appointed Examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on October 27, 1994, that notice be given as required by law, the Division enter its order granting this application and providing such other relief as is proper.
