CARROLL: Application of Meridian Oil, Inc., 5 for downhole commingling, San Juan County, New Mexico. 6 7 EXAMINER CATANACH: Appearances in this case? 8 MR. KELLAHIN: If the Examiner please, I'm Tom 9 Kellahin of the Santa Fe law firm of Kellahin and Kellahin, appearing on behalf of the Applicant. 10 EXAMINER CATANACH: Are there any additional 11 appearances in this case? 12 MR. KELLAHIN: Mr. Examiner, for the record let 13 me remind you that Mr. Orville Slaughter has entered a 14 15 facsimile displaying his interest in this matter. Mr. Slaughter is present in the hearing room, and he's this 16 gentleman off to my left. 17 I have visited with him this morning, and I am 18 persuaded he has no objection in this particular case, and 19 you're certainly invited to ask him if he has any 20 objection, but I am not aware of any opposition. 21 EXAMINER CATANACH: Mr. Slaughter you don't 22 23 intend to object to this Application? 24 MR. SLAUGHTER: No, I do not. I just have been in that Fruitland sand for about 40 years, and I've become 25

possessive about it, and I -- but I'm not opposing any objections at this time.

MR. KELLAHIN: We've provided Mr. Slaughter with copies of the exhibits, and he has that information.

EXAMINER CATANACH: Is there any need to go into a formal presentation in this case, Mr. Kellahin?

MR. KELLAHIN: I'm aware of none, Mr. Examiner.

EXAMINER CATANACH: Okay.

MR. KELLAHIN: The reason this case is before you is that except for the ownership difference within the spacing units, all other matters are in conformance with Division Rule 303. The difference in ownership is between the Pictured Cliff 160 spacing unit and the coal gas 320 unit.

Again, you'll find in this exhibit book that's been pre-filed with you a list of the names, addresses, kinds of interests of the parties within those two spacing units, and then a list of the photocopies of the green cards.

You will also find in that list that the offset operators have been notified. So what you're looking at behind Exhibit Tab Number 2 is a combination of both interest owners and offset operators. You can distinguish the two by looking at the ownership plats right behind the Application in Exhibit 1. It will give you an ownership

plat, it will be coded by number, and you can use the 1 number, then, and follow the index at the bottom and see 2 who the offsets are. 3 But for the ownership difference within the 4 units, this would be eligible for approval as an 5 administrative application. 6 At this time, Mr. Examiner, we move the 7 8 introduction of Exhibits 1 through 8, plus the opportunity 9 to submit a post-hearing certificate of notice for your consideration. 10 EXAMINER CATANACH: Okay, Exhibits 1 through 8 11 will be admitted in this case. 12 And there being nothing further, Case 11,135 will 13 be taken under advisement. 14 (Thereupon, these proceedings were concluded at 15 8:29 a.m.) 16 17 18 19 20 21 22 23 24 25
