On October 30, 1995 the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division entered Order No. R-10496 granting the application of Nearburg Exploration Company in the above-referenced case. The original Order required Nearburg to commence drilling of the well authorized by this Order on or before January 1, 1996. At Nearburg's request this deadline was extended by the Division until April 1, 1996.

Nearburg intends to drill its Shriner No. 2 Well in the NW/4 of Section 13, Township 17 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico pursuant to the provisions of Order No. R-10496. Recently, however, Nearburg has experienced delays in its negotiations to secure surface location pad off the lease for this directional well and therefore, must request an additional extension of time within which to commence drilling.
