

PROPOSED ADVERTISEMENT

Case 1331: Application of Meridian Oil Inc. for downhole commingling, a non-standard gas proration unit and an unorthodox well location, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. Applicant, in the above-styled cause, seeks approval to downhole commingle conventional East Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Gas Pool gas production (320-acre non-standard E/2 dedication) with coal gas production from the Basin-Fruitland Coal Gas Pool (320-acre standard E/2 dedication) and to dual said commingled production with production from the Blanco Mesaverde Gas Pool within the wellbore of its San Juan 30-4 Unit Well No. 40 to be drilled at an unorthodox location 2450 feet from the South line and 2270 feet from the East line (Unit J) of Section 21, T30N, R4W, NMPM. Said well location is both an unorthodox "off-pattern" coal-gas well location and an unorthodox Pictured Cliff's well location. Said well is located approximately 18 miles southwest of Dulce, New Mexico.
