

On August 29, 1995, the Division entered Order No. R-10447 in the above-referenced case pooling all formations from the surface to the base of the Strawn formation underlying the NW/4 NW/4 of Section 9, Township 17 South, Range 38 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. This Order provided that AnSon should commence drilling of a well on this acreage on or before December 1, 1995, or obtain an extension from the Director of the Division for good cause shown.


AnSon intends to drill the High Lonesome 9 #1 Well on this acreage during the first quarter of 1996. However, it is currently evaluating the results of a well which it has drilled on an offsetting tract and, accordingly, is requesting an extension of the above-referenced Order for ninety (90) days to permit to conclude this evaluation prior to spudding the High Lonesome 9 #1 Well.
