STATEMENT OF CASE

APPLICANT

Oxy proposes to drill its Oxy 4 Federal Well No. 1 at an unorthodox gas well location 1980 feet FNL and 2130 feet FEL of Section 4, T20S, R28E to test for production from the surface to the base of the Morrow formation including but not limited to the Old Millman Ranch-Bone Springs Associated Pool which provides for 40-acre oil and 80-acre gas spacing and proration units and the North Burton Flat-Wolfcamp Gas Pool, the Winchester-Morrow Gas Pool, the Winchester-Strawn Gas Pool, the Winchester-Atoka Gas Pool and the Burton Flat-Morrow Gas Pool which provide for 320 acre gas spacing and proration units.

All of the potential gas productive formations below the top of the Wolfcamp are very risky and cannot be justified by drilling a separate well at a standard "deep gas" well location. However, that risk can be justified if this proposed Bone Springs well is drilled to those deeper formations.

The well will be located at a standard well location for any oil production and for gas production from the Bone Springs formation but will be at an unorthodox gas well location for any production below the top of the Wolfcamp formation.
