APPLICATION

Exxon Corporation hereby applies for a non-standard gas spacing and proration unit and simultaneous dedication, and in support thereof states:

1. Applicant is the operator of the New Mexico "S" State Lease, which covers all of Section 2, Township 22 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, in Lea County. The lease is within the limits of the Blinebry Oil and Gas Pool. The special rules and regulations for the pool require 160 acre gas well units consisting of a governmental quarter section.

2. Applicant requests a non-standard gas spacing and proration unit in said pool, consisting of the E $\frac{1}{2}$ W $\frac{1}{2}$, SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, and NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 2. Further, Applicant requests authorization to simultaneously dedicate to the unit its New Mexico "S" State Well Nos. 14 (Unit C), 38 (Unit E), 28 (Unit F), 27 (Unit K), 21 (Unit L), and 42 (Unit N).

3. If the foregoing request is granted, Division Order No. R-10063, Division Administrative Order NSP-1667, and Division Administrative Order NSP-1734(L) will be superseded.

4. The granting of this application is in the interests of conservation and the prevention of waste.

WHEREFORE, Applicant requests that, after notice and hearing,
the Division grant the relief requested above.
