**APPLICATION**

NEARBURG PRODUCING COMPANY, L.L.C. ("Nearburg"), by its undersigned attorneys, hereby makes application for approval of an unorthodox well location and for directional drilling and in support thereof states:

1. Nearburg is the operator of an existing 320-acre spacing and proration unit in the Canyon formation, Undesignated Indian Basin-Upper Pennsylvanian Associated Pool, comprised of the N/2 of Section 11, Township 22 South, Range 24 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico which is dedicated to its Chama Federal No. 1 Well located 780 feet from the North line and 1350 feet from the East line of Said Section 11.

2. Nearburg proposes to directionally drill its proposed McKittrick Federal 11 Well No. 1-Y as an additional Cisco Canyon well on this spacing unit as permitted by the General Rules and Regulations for the Associated Oil and Gas Pools of Northwest and Southeast New Mexico. This new well will be drilled from a surface location 2310 feet from the South line and 960 feet from the East line to a bottom hole location 2550 feet from

the North line and 400 feet from the East line of said Section 11. This N/2 spacing unit will be simultaneously dedicated to these wells and will be the "project area" for the McKittrick Federal 11 Well No. 1-Y which Nearburg seeks authority to directionally drill from a standard surface location 2310 feet from the South line and 960 feet from the East line (Unit I) of Section 11, Township 22 South, Range 24 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico. Nearburg proposes to directionally drill in a northeasterly direction to a bottomhole location within 100 feet of a point 2550 feet from the North line and 400 feet from the East line of said Section 11 in the Canyon formation. The bottomhole location is unorthodox since it will be closer to the southern and eastern boundary of the project area than permitted by rule.


3. Approval of this application and the drilling of the proposed well will be in the best interest of conservation, the prevention of waste and the protection of correlative rights.

WHEREFORE, Nearburg Producing Company, L.L.C., requests that this application be set for hearing before a duly appointed Examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on January 9, 1997, and after notice and hearing as required by law, the Division enter its order granting this application (1) approving an unorthodox bottomhole location for the well 2550 feet from the North line and 400 feet from the East line of Section 11, Township 22 South, Range 24 East; and (2) authorizing the directional drilling of said well in the Canyon formation.


