Reference is made to: (i) your application dated June 9, 1997; (ii) the Division's initial response to said application from Mr. Michael E. Stogner by letter dated July 10, 1997; (iii) your response by letter dated July 15, 1997; and, (iv) to the records in Division Case 11767: all of which concern Merrion Oil & Gas Corporation's request to drill its proposed Powell Well No. 1 at an unorthodox coal gas well location 2050 feet from the North line and 790 feet from the East line (Unit H) of Section 22, Township 32 North, Range 13 West, NMPM, Basin Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico. The N/2 of said Section 22 is to be dedicated to said well to form a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 8 of the "*Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Fruitland Coal Gas Pool*", as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8768, as amended, the above-described unorthodox coal gas well location is hereby approved.
