

PROPOSED ADVERTISEMENT FOR NMOCD DOCKET

CASE 11546: Application of Burlington Resources Oil & Gas Company for compulsory pooling and a non-standard proration and spacing unit, San Juan County, New Mexico. Applicant seeks an order pooling all mineral owners, including working interest, royalty interests and overriding royalty interests below the base of the Dakota formation (base of the Cretaceous aged formation) to the top of the Pre-Cambrian aged formation underlying all of Irregular Section 9, T31N, R10W, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, forming a non-standard 636.01-acre gas spacing and proration unit for any formations and/or pools developed on 640-acre gas spacing within said vertical extent. Applicant seeks to be designated as the operator of the well. Said unit is to be dedicated to Burlington Resources Oil & Gas Company's Scott Well No. 24 which is to be drilled at a standard gas well location 1535 feet from the north line and 2500 feet from the west line, Unit F of said Section 9. Said well is located approximately 2-1/2 miles southeast of Cedar Hills, New Mexico.
