Application of the Oil Conservation Division for an order requiring Hanson Energy to plug seventeen (17) wells in Eddy County, New Mexico. In the matter of the hearing called by the Oil Conservation Division ("Division") to permit the operator, Hanson Energy, Gulf Insurance Company, and all other interested parties to appear and show cause why seventeen (17) wells located in Township 18 South, Range 28 East and Township 17 South, Ranges 27 and 28 East, Eddy County, New Mexico, should not be plugged and abandoned in accordance with a Division-approved plugging program.
