APPLICATION

McELVAIN OIL & GAS PROPERTIES, INC. ("McElvain"), through its undersigned attorneys, hereby makes application pursuant to the provisions of N.M.Stat.Ann. § 70-2-17, (1978), for an order pooling all mineral interests in all formations developed on 320-acre spacing in Lots 3 and 4, S/2 NW/4, SW/4 (West half equivalent) of Section 3, Township 25 North, Range 2 West, N.M.P.M., Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states:

1. McElvain owns or represents 50.151104% of the working interest in the West half of said Section 3 and has the right to drill thereon.

2. McElvain proposes to dedicate the above-referenced spacing or proration unit to its Elk Com Well No. 1 which to be drilled at a standard location in the NW/4 of said Section 3 to test the Mesaverde formation, Blanco-Mesaverde Gas Pool.

3. McElvain has sought and been unable to obtain either voluntary agreement for the development of this spacing unit from the interest owners identified on Exhibit A to this application. 4. Said pooling of interests will avoid the drilling of unnecessary wells, will prevent waste and will protect correlative rights.

5. In order to permit McElvain to obtain its just and fair share of the oil and gas underlying the subject lands, all mineral interests should be pooled, and McElvain Oil & Gas Properties, should be designated the operator of the well to be drilled.

WHEREFORE, McElvain Oil & Gas Properties. Inc. requests that this application be set for hearing before an Examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on August 7, 1997 and, after notice and hearing as required by law, the Division enter its order pooling the lands, including provisions naming McElvain Oil & Gas Properties, Inc. operator of the pool spacing and proration unit and the wells located thereon and authorizing McElvain to recover its costs of drilling, equipping and completing the well, its costs of supervision while drilling and after completion, including overhead charges, and imposing a risk factor for the risk assumed by the McElvain in drilling, completing and equipping the well.
