25   1998, in prorated fields in southeast and northwest New

2 Appearances in Case 11,829?

3 If there are no appearances, the assumption is  
4 that the default allowables as put out on the docket that  
5 you all received that was mailed out, that those allowables  
6 will be enacted for the allowable period.

7 Thank you very much, we shall take the case under  
8 advisement.

9 Is that -- Commissioners, do you have anything to  
10 say on the allowable case?

11 COMMISSIONER WEISS: Let's take it under  
12 advisement.

13 CHAIRMAN LEMAY: Shall we take it under  
14 advisement, Commissioner?

15 COMMISSIONER BAILEY: Sounds like a good idea.

16 CHAIRMAN LEMAY: Fine, we shall weigh the  
17 evidence heavily and take this case under advisement.
