Applicant seeks to reinstate Division Order No. R-1084-B, dated May 23, 1991, which authorized a 440-acre non-standard gas spacing and proration unit ("GPU") in the Eumont Gas Pool comprising the SW/4 of Section 1 and the NE/4, N/2 NW/4, and SE/4 NW/4 of Section 12, both in Township 22 South Range 36 East, which is located approximately 4 miles westsouthwest of Eunice, New Mexico. Applicant further seeks approval of an unorthodox Eumont gas well location for said 440-acre GPU of its existing H. T. Mattern (NCT-E) Well No. 3 (API No. 30-025-08880), located 660 feet from the North and West lines (Unit D) of said Section 12. Eumont gas production attributed to said 440-acre GPU is to be simultaneously dedicated to said H. T. Mattern (NCT-E) Well No. 3 and its H. T. Mattern (NCT-E) Well Nos. 10, 11, and 13 located in Unit "N" of said Section 1 and Units "B" and "H" of said Section 12, respectively. In the absence of objection, this application will be taken under advisement.
