SEEKING AUTHORITY TO OPERATE THE FEDERAL I CENTRAL GATHERING SYSTEM LOCATED IN SAN JUAN COUNTY, WHICH WILL REQUIRE SURFACE COMMINGLING OF PRODUCTION FROM THE HARPER HILL FRUITLAND SAND-PICTURED CLIFFS PLUS THE BASIN FRUITLAND COAL GAS POOLS, ALONG WITH OFF-LEASE MEASUREMENT PLUS ALLOCATION OF CENTRAL BATTERY PRODUCTION TO INDIVIDUAL WELLS USING ALLOCATION FACTORS DETERMINED FROM PERIODIC WELL TESTS.

STATEMENT OF CASE

APPLICANT

Dugan Production Corp. is seeking authority to operate it's recently constructed Federal I Central Gathering System located in Sections 1 of T-29N, R-14W plus Sections 35 and 36 of T-30N, R-14W of San Juan County, NM. It is proposed to send all production (gas and water) to a central battery located at Dugan's Federal I Well No. 4 (Unit C, Section 1, T-29N, R-14W). Commingled gas production will be sold to El Paso Field Services thru a CPD meter located at the central battery and commingled water production will be transferred to Dugan's Stella Needs A Com No. 1E water disposal well. Production will be allocated to individual wells based upon factors established by periodic individual well tests. This will require the surface commingling and off-lease measurement of production from 6 wells, all operated by Dugan Production Corp., and completed in the Harper Hill Fruitland Sand-Pictured Cliffs, and the Basin Fruitland Coal gas pools. The spacing units for these 6 wells include State, Federal and/or Fee leases and ownership is not common. This matter was initially submitted to the NMOCD, Bureau of Land Management (BLM) and New Mexico State Land Office (NMSLO) on 8-19-97 requesting Administrative approval from each agency. Dugan's application was approved by the NMSLO on 8-26-97 and by the BLM on 9-22-97. The uncommon ownership and proposed central battery allocation using periodic well tests required this matter to be considered before an NMOCD hearing.
