



This letter is to advise you that Yates Petroleum Corporation has filed the enclosed application with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division seeking approval of an unorthodox well location for its State K No. 4 Well drilled at a standard location 1980 feet from the South line and 660 feet from the West line of said Section 28, Township 19 South, Range 25 East, NMPM, in the Morrow formation, Cemetary Morrow-Gas Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico. The S/2 of said Section 28 will be dedicated thereto.

This application has been set for hearing before a Division Examiner on November 6, 1997. You are not required to attend this hearing, but as an owner of an interest that may be affected by the unorthodox well locations, you may appear and present testimony. Failure to appear at that time and become a party of record will preclude you from challenging the matter at a later date.

Parties appearing in cases have been requested by the Division (Memorandum 2-90) to file a Prehearing Statement substantially in the form prescribed by the Division. Prehearing statements should be filed by 4:00 o'clock p.m. on the Friday before a scheduled hearing.


