APPLICATION OF MEWBOURNE OIL COMPANY FOR COMPULSORY POOLING, EDDY COUNTY, NEW MEXICO.

APPLICATION

Mewbourne Oil Company hereby applies for an order pooling all mineral interests from the surface to the base of the Cisco/Canyon formation underlying Lots 1, 2, and the S½NE¼ (the NE¾) of Section 5, Township 20 South, Range 25 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states:

- 1. Applicant is a working interest owner in the NE% of said Section 5, containing 160.45 acres, and has the right to drill a well thereon.
- 2. Applicant proposes to drill its S.P. Johnson Com. Well No. 2, at an orthodox oil well location 1650 feet from the North line and 1980 feet from the West line of the Section, to a depth sufficient to test the Cisco/Canyon formation (approximately 8100 feet subsurface), and seeks to dedicate the following acreage to the well:
 - (a) The NE% of Section 5 for all pools or formations spaced on 160 acres, including the Undesignated North Dagger Draw-Upper Pennsylvanian Pool; and
 - (b) The SW1/NE% of Section 5 for all pools or formations spaced on 40 acres, including the Undesignated Seven Rivers-Yeso Pool.

- 3. Applicant has in good faith sought to obtain the voluntary joinder of all other mineral interest owners in the NE% of Section 5 for the purposes set forth herein.
- 4. Although applicant attempted to obtain voluntary agreements from all mineral interest owners to participate in the drilling of the well or to otherwise commit their interests to the well, certain interest owners have failed or refused to join in dedicating their interests. Therefore, applicant seeks an order pooling all mineral interest owners in the NE¼ of Section 5, pursuant to N.M. Stat. Ann. § 70-2-17 (1995 Repl. Pamp.).
- 5. The pooling of all mineral interests underlying the NE% of Section 5, as set forth above, will prevent the drilling of unnecessary wells, prevent waste, and protect correlative rights.

WHEREFORE, Applicant requests that, after notice and hearing, the Division enter its order:

- (a) Pooling all mineral interests in the NE% of Section 5, from the surface to the base of the Cisco/Canyon formation;
- (b) Designating applicant as operator of the well;
- (c) Considering the cost of drilling and completing the well, and allocating the cost thereof among the well's working interest owners;
- (d) Approving actual operating charges and costs charged for supervision, together with a provision adjusting said rates as provided in the COPAS accounting procedure;

- (e) Setting a penalty for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well in the event a working interest owner elects not to participate in the well; and
- (f) Granting such further relief as the Division deems proper.
