1 WHEREUPON, the following proceedings were had at 8:20 a.m.: 2 EXAMINER STOGNER: This hearing will come to 3 order for the Docket Number 2-98. Please note today's 4 date, Thursday, January 22nd, 1998. I'm Michael Stogner, 5 appointed Hearing Examiner for today's cases. 6 7 At this time I will call Case Number 11,908. 8 MR. CARROLL: Application of Marathon Oil Company for compulsory pooling, Eddy County, New Mexico. 9 EXAMINER STOGNER: At this time I will call for 10 11 appearances. MR. KELLAHIN: Mr. Examiner, I'm Tom Kellahin of 12 the Santa Fe law firm of Kellahin and Kellahin, appearing 13 on behalf of the Applicant. 14 Mr. Examiner, we would request that you continue 15 this case for two weeks. There are ten working interest 16 owners involved in this spacing unit, and as of last week 17 18 we were down to three parties who had not signed written They were Louis Dreyfus, Enron and KCS agreements. 19 Medallion. 20

As of the 15th of January, we've received verbal commitments from those companies, and my expectation is that if it's continued for two weeks, then we'll have time to execute the written documents that will confirm the verbal agreements, and then we can save all of ourselves

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some time and just dismiss this case in two weeks.

EXAMINER STOGNER: Mr. Kellahin, it's usually my policy to continue for four weeks. What -- If it looks like there's going to be a dismissal on it, what's the big hurry on --

MR. KELLAHIN: This is part of a Morrow drilling program, and we've got a rig scheduled for this well in April. I'm concerned if we move it back to late February, waiting for the order and then the additional 30 days notice, is going to put us right up against the spud date for the well.

EXAMINER STOGNER: What additional 30 days?

February 19th is still pretty far from April, isn't it?

MR. KELLAHIN: The Division policy, as I understand it, is 30 days to issue the order after the hearing. If it comes sooner than that, fine. If not, then it will be March, mid-March, and then we have to give notice to these parties of the pooling order, and that puts us in mid-April.

I truly believe the case will go away.

EXAMINER STOGNER: Mr. Kellahin, if it looks like the case will go away, I will continue this for two weeks. If it looks like it's going to go away, then so be it. But if not, then we'll continue it for another two weeks at that time --

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MR. KELLAHIN: All right, sir.
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                EXAMINER STOGNER: -- and hear it on February
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     19th.

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     5th. Please keep us apprised, Mr. Kellahin.
