APPLICATION

MANZANO OIL CORPORATION, ("Manzano") by its undersigned attorneys, hereby makes application to the Oil Conservation Division for an Order promulgating special pool rules and regulations for Featherstone-Bone Spring Pool including provisions for 80-acre spacing and special well location requirements, and in support of this application states:

1. The Featherstone Bone Spring Pool was created by the Oil Conservation Division by Order No. R-7030 and has been extended from time to time to include the following acreage:

Township 20 South, Range 35 East, NMPM

Section 21: NE/4 Section 22: N/2

2. Manzano has recently recompleted its Appleseed Federal Well No. 1 from the Morrow formation to the Bone-Spring formation, Undesignated Featherstone-Bone Spring Pool. Said well is capable of draining in excess of the 40-acre spacing unit which is dedicated to it pursuant to the General Rules and Regulations of the Oil Conservation Division.

3. Operating this pool under Statewide rules which provide for 40-acre spacing and proration units in the Bone Spring formation will result in the drilling of unnecessary wells, inefficient operations and will cause waste.

4. Manzano seeks the adoption of Special Rules and Regulations for the Featherstone-Bone Spring Pool to provide for 80-acre spacing and to permit wells to be located within 150 feet of the center of a governmental quarter-quarter section.

5. Approval of this application will protect the correlative rights of each owner in the pool by affording them the opportunity to produce their just and equitable share of the reserves in the pool, will prevent waste of hydrocarbons and will otherwise be in the best interest of conservation.

WHEREFORE, Manzano Oil Corporation requests that this application be set for hearing before a Division Examiner on July 9, 1998 and that after notice and hearing as required by law and the rules of the Division, that this application be granted.
