WHEREUPON, the following proceedings were had at 1 2 3:20 p.m.: 3 EXAMINER STOGNER: This hearing will come to order. I'll call Case Number 12,007, which is the 4 Application of Chesapeake Operating, Inc., for compulsory 5 pooling and directional drilling, Lea County, New Mexico. 6 7 At this time I'll call for appearances and/or statements. 8 MR. KELLAHIN: Mr. Examiner, I'm Tom Kellahin of 9 the Santa Fe law firm of Kellahin and Kellahin. 10 11 represent the Applicant, Chesapeake Operating Company. 12 EXAMINER STOGNER: Any other appearances? MR. CARR: May it please the Examiner, my name is 13 William F. Carr with the Santa Fe law firm Campbell, Carr, 14 Berge and Sheridan. We represent Bahlburg Exploration in 15 this matter. 16 EXAMINER STOGNER: Any other appearances? 17 Okay, Mr. Kellahin, could you bring me up to date 18 on this or --19 MR. KELLAHIN: Yes, sir. I've lost of my days 20 this week, but I think it was on Tuesday, I received a 21 phone call from Mike Hazlip, indicating that he had 22 23 believed that on behalf of his company, Chesapeake, that he had reached a settlement with Mr. Bahlburg and that he was 24 waiting for confirmation of that issue. 25

I called Mr. Carr the next morning. He found out from his client the same information I was hearing from my client.

Neither one of us have received written confirmation of this, but based upon the mutual representations by both parties, I'm prepared to dismiss the Chesapeake Application.

It has a directional drilling component to it, which had been started with Chris Williams in the District as an administrative application under Rule 111. We will still need the approval of that Application, but I believe the dismissal of the hearing case does not preclude us from going forward and having the Division issue an administrative order for the directional wellbore.

The compulsory pooling issue is resolved because the parties have agreed to some configuration of the spacing unit and commitment of the working interest owners. My understanding is, the units are going to stay as standups, but there is some comprehensive agreement for settlement, and based upon those representations, then, we would ask you to dismiss the Chesapeake case.

EXAMINER STOGNER: Mr. Carr?

MR. CARR: Mr. Stogner, I can't add much to what Mr. Kellahin has already stated. I've been advised by Bahlburg that they have reached an agreement with

That, coupled with the fact that no one showed 1 Chesapeake. up for hearing, suggests to me that they, in fact, have a 2 settlement. Having not seen it, however, I do believe that 3 4 it's appropriate to dismiss the case and to proceed with approving the directional drilling portion of the 5 Chesapeake case with an administrative application. 6 7 EXAMINER STOGNER: With the appearance of Mr. Kellahin and Mr. Carr as respective legal counsels for the 8 Applicant and for Bahlburg Exploration, Case Number 12,007 9 10 will be dismissed at this time, and Chesapeake Operating will be able to seek such relief pursuant to Rule 111 for 11 its directional drilling proposal. 12 13 Case 12,007 is dismissed.
