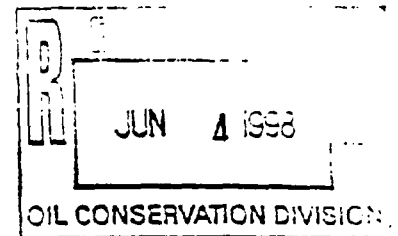

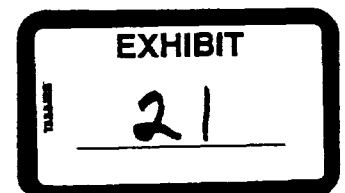

Nos. 2 and 2Y which it has drilled on this pooled unit.




