

CASE 12618:

Application of Bahlburg Exploration Inc. for compulsory pooling and directional drilling, Lea County, New Mexico. Applicant in the above-styled cause seeks an order pooling all mineral interests from the surface to the base of the Strawn formation, Northeast Lovington Pennsylvanian Pool underlying the N/2 NW/4 of Section 10, Township 16 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, for all formations developed on 80-acre spacing. Applicant proposes to dedicate said spacing unit to its City of Lovington 10 Well No. 1 to be directionally drilled from a surface location 215 feet from the South line and 2435 feet from the East line of Section 3, Township 16 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, to a standard bottom hole location in the Strawn formation within 50 feet of a point 510 feet from the North line and 1830 feet from West line of said Section 10. Also to be considered will the cost of drilling and completing said well and the allocation of the cost thereof as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the well and a charge for risk involved in drilling said well. Said area is located in the City of Lovington, New Mexico.

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
