Dear Mr. Gum:

We received original's of Form C-103, filed by Gary Millspaugh, for 14 wells in Chaves County, New Mexico, reflecting Mr. Millspaugh as agent for The Harlow Corporation.

We have enclosed copies of the forms shown received by and approved by N.M.O.C.C. These forms reflect that you expect casing integrity test to begin after May 11th on these wells.

The Harlow Corporation has nothing to do with these wells or these leases as of the effective date of sale to Mr. Millspaugh dba Willow Pipeline Company, March 1, 1996.

It should be noted at this point that Mr. Millspaugh has informed myself as well as the Commission that he has entered all of these wells for testing and operations, including production, since purchased from The Harlow Corporation and represented to us that Millspaugh and/or his operating company were bonded to do business in New Mexico.

Apparently, Mr. Millspaugh continues to be at odds with the Commission's request to perform certain activities on these wells and is using our name without our permission legally, or otherwise, to conduct the requested operations on these wells.

We have not agreed to have Mr. Millspaugh act as our agent in any capacity.
