On behalf of Matador Petroleum Corporation and in accordance with the terms of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division Order R-11111, copy enclosed, I am providing you with notice of your right to elect to participate in the well to be drilled pursuant to this order.

Our records indicate that you have a working interest ownership in the spacing unit for all formations from the top of the Wolfcamp to the base of the Morrow formation in the spacing unit proposed for this well.
