
Nearburg Exploration Company, L.L.C. applies for approval of an unorthodox gas well location in the N½ of Section 19, Township 22 South, Range 24 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states:

1. Applicant is the working interest owner of said Section 19, and proposes to drill its Cone Butte "19" Fed. Well No. 1, at an unorthodox gas well location 622 feet from the North line and 1987 feet from the East line (Unit B) of Section 19, to a depth sufficient to test the Morrow formation (Undesignated South Indian Basin-Morrow Gas Pool). Applicant requests unorthodox location approval for all zones from the top of the Cisco formation to the base of the Morrow formation.

2. Approval of the unorthodox location will prevent waste and protect correlative rights.

**WHEREFORE**, applicant requests that the Division enter its order approving the unorthodox gas well location.
