

PROPOSED ADVERTISEMENT

Case 12103 (Reopened):

Application of Nearburg Exploration Company, L.L.C. and E.G.L. Resources, Inc. to reopen Case No. 12103 and for compulsory pooling, Lea County, New Mexico. Applicant seeks order reopening Case No. 12103 and pooling all mineral interests from the surface to the base of the Bone Spring formation underlying the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 3, Township 20 South, Range 33 East, NMPM, to form a standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit for any formations and/or pools developed on 40-acre spacing within said vertical extent, including the Undesignated Teas Yates-Seven Rivers Pool. Said unit is to be dedicated to a well to be drilled at an orthodox oil well location in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 3. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing said well and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of Nearburg Producing Company as operator of the well, and a charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well. Said unit is located approximately 5.5 miles northeast of the intersection of State Highway 176 and U.S. Highway 62/180.
