

In January 1999, GP II Energy, Inc. mailed to you a copy of its application for approval of a waterflood project in its North Square Lake Unit Area located in portions of Township 16 South, Ranges 30 and 31 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico. The North Lake Unit has been formed pursuant to the New Mexico Statutory Unitization Act and became effective on January 1, 2000. The Oil Conservation Division did not enter an order on GP II Energy, Inc.'s applications for approval of the waterflood project and requested that GP II Energy, Inc. compile additional information on the wells in the areas of review for each injection well. Enclosed is a copy of GP II's revised Application for Authorization to Inject which contains information on the wells in the first two Phases of the waterflood operations in the North Square Lake Unit. GP II Energy, Inc. has requested that the case be re-opened on June 1, 2000 for an additional hearing before an Oil Conservation Division Examiner.
