WHEREUPON, the following proceedings were had at 1:03 p.m.:

EXAMINER CATANACH: Okay, we'll call the hearing back to order and call Case 12,146.

MR. CARROLL: Application of Devon Energy
Corporation (Nevada) for surface commingling and lease
commingling, Eddy County, New Mexico.

EXAMINER CATANACH: Call for appearances.

MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, Jim Bruce of Santa Fe, representing the Applicant. I have do not have any witnesses, I just have a brief presentation.

Mr. Examiner, in this case Devon Energy seeks an exception to Division Rules 303.B and 309.B to permit approval of surface and lease commingling of production from the Red Lake-Queen-Grayburg-San Andres Pool and the Undesignated Northeast Red Lake-Glorieta-Yeso Pool. The land involved is the west half northeast quarter and southeast northwest quarter of Section 18, 18 South, 27 East.

I've handed you three exhibits. The first exhibit is the Application explaining the procedure and setup for this Application. You'll notice that these wells, except for one, have been drilled. They produce at low rates.

The third page of the exhibit outlines the lease

involved. Although it's just called the Kaiser B lease, the ownership in the northwest quarter of the northeast quarter is different from the ownership in the other 80 acres.

The ownership is set forth on Exhibit 2. The first two pages show the ownership of the two wells in the northwest quarter of the northeast quarter, and the other three pages show the ownership in the remaining 80 acres. Notice to all of the interest owners was given by means of the -- as shown on the affidavit marked Exhibit 3.

As noted in the prehearing statement, this

Application is similar to a number of others which Devon
has filed in this area. What they're asking to do is to
perform periodic well tests, not less than monthly, to
allocate production and to commingle production from these
formations in a common tank battery on this acreage, in
order to save a substantial amount of operating costs.

And that's all I have.

EXAMINER CATANACH: Okay. There aren't any additional appearances in this case at this time?

There being nothing further in this case, Case 12,146 will be taken under advisement.
