OWEN: 10 Campbell, Carr, Berge and Sheridan, on behalf of the 11 Applicant, Chi Energy, Inc. 12 EXAMINER CATANACH: Any additional appearances? 13 Okay, Mr. Owen? MR. OWEN: Mr. Examiner, this case was originally 14 15 heard by Mr. Stogner on May 13th, and all the evidence, all 16 the substantive evidence in this case, was taken at that 17 time. 18 At that hearing it was determined that one individual, Mr. James Burr, had not been fully notified of 19 these proceedings. Since that time our office has notified 20 21 Mr. Burr of the pending Application and today's hearing 22 date. 23 And I offer as evidence of that notification Chi 24 Energy Exhibit Number 12, which is sequentially the next 25 exhibit following the exhibits that were introduced at the

May 13th hearing. That exhibit is an affidavit from Mr. 1 Carr of our office, evidencing Mr. James Burr's 2 notification of this proceeding. 3 In addition, at the time of the May 13th hearing 4 full agreement had not been reached with Santa Fe Energy, 5 Since that time, I can affirmatively state that Santa 6 Inc. Fe and Chi have reached an understanding, and Santa Fe 7 supports Chi's Application at this time. 8 With the evidence of the additional notice and 9 Santa Fe's support for Chi's Application in the record, we 10 request that Chi's Application be approved at this time, 11 Mr. Examiner. 12 13 EXAMINER CATANACH: Okay, Exhibit 12 will be admitted as evidence in this case. 14 And there being nothing further, Case 12,157 will 15 16 be taken under advisement. 17 MR.
