24 10th, or at that time we will advise you that the parties
25 have reached agreement.

3 MR. CARR: Yes, sir.

4 EXAMINER STOGNER: Is that correct.

5 MR. CARR: The Santa Fe Application.

6 EXAMINER STOGNER: Okay. Case Number 12,157 will
7 be continued to the Hearing Examiner scheduled for June the
8 10th.


