

Marathon has drilled its Walker State Well No. 1 on its Walker "33" State Lease in the W/2 of Section 33, T18S, R28E and desires to amend Order R-11112 so that production from this lease can be commingled with previous approved production from other leases which shall be stored and measured at its centralized facility located in Unit I, Section 33, T18S, R28E. **See Exhibit "A".**


3. The ownership in the W/2 of Section 33 is not identical with the ownership of the other commingled production.

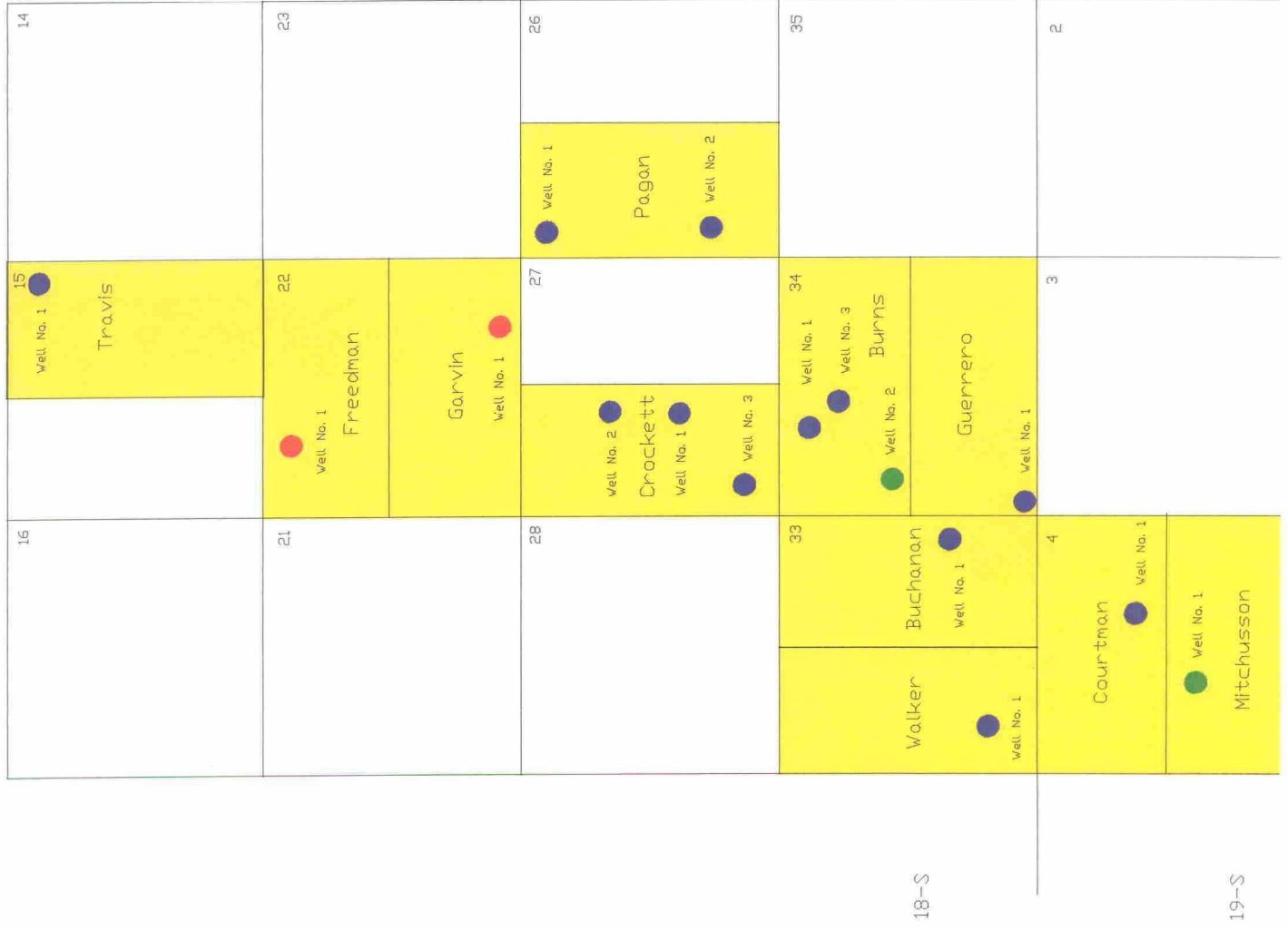
Accordingly, Marathon requests that this application be set for hearing before a Division Examiner and that after notice and hearing, the Division grant this application as requested.
