21	owns the shallow rights, it does not own any Wolfcamp	
22	rights. So although I attach that, the letter is	
23	essentially unnecessary.	
24	The entire northeast quarter of Section 15 is one

As a 1 result, the well is only moving toward the same people who 2 own all of the interest in this well.
