OXY USA Inc. has received your application, currently set for an examiner hearing on May 27, 1999. As you know, your proposed location encroaches on the Morrow spacing unit assigned to the OXY/Roscoe Fed Well #1. This well <u>does not</u> produce from the prolific Morrow sand which we both suspect underlies the northeast quarter of section 5 (where your proposed well is located) and the northwest quarter of section 4 (currently assigned to the Roscoe Fed #1 well). Consequently, completion of the Lucky Coyote "ATD" Well #1 at the proposed unorthodox location could drain our reserves from this prolific Morrow zone and adversely affect our correlative rights. The Roscoe Fed #1 well is currently producing around 350 MCFPD. Permanent abandonment of this zone in order to drill a new well in the NW/4 of section 4 will cause waste.

Therefore, OXY is submitting an application to the OCD for the June 10th docket for approval to drill and produce the Jazz Federal #1 well at an unorthodox gas well location 660 FWL & 1980 FNL of section 4, and simultaneous dedication (in the Morrow only) of the N/2 of section 4 to this proposed well and the Roscoe Fed #1. In our opinion, approval of this request would address our concerns about the adverse impact of the Lucky Coyote "ATD" Well #1. Therefore we agree to waive any protest to your application for the subject unorthodox location, provided Yates waives any objection to our application. We also propose to exchange well and ownership information. Since Yates is a working interest owner in the Roscoe Federal Well #1, you agree to allow the plugback or temporary abandonment of the Morrow zone in the Roscoe Federal Well #1, should it become necessary to secure regulatory approval to produce the Jazz Federal #1 well in the Morrow formation. Yates also agrees that it will not exercise well takeover rights as set forth in the Operating Agreement that governs operations of the Roscoe Federal Well #1.
