1	WHEREUPON, the following proceedings were had at
2	9:00 a.m.:
3	CHAIRMAN WROTENBERY: Okay, it's 9:00 a.m. on
4	July 15th, 1999. We're in the Oil Conservation Commission
5	conference room in Santa Fe, New Mexico. This is a meeting
6	of the Oil Conservation Commission.
7	I'm Lori Wrotenbery, Chairman of the Commission.
8	To my right is Commissioner Jami Bailey representing Land
9	Commissioner Ray Powell on the Commission, and then to my
10	left is Commissioner Robert Lee.
11	We also have Florene Davidson the Commission
12	Secretary, Lyn Hebert the Commission's legal counsel, and
13	Steve Brenner is going to be recording the meeting for us
14	today.
15	We've got one preliminary matter, and that's the
16	minutes of the last Commission meeting on June 17th, 1999.
17	Commissioners, I believe you've seen a copy of
18	the draft of the minutes. There was one change that we
19	made this morning, and that was in the third paragraph of
20	the minutes where we changed one word to reflect the fact
21	that we took we discussed the notice rules at the last
22	meeting. We didn't take any additional testimony on those
23	at that time, so we changed one word from "testimony" to
24	"discussion".
25	COMMISSIONER BAILEY: Sounds good to me.

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1 CHAIRMAN WROTENBERY: And do I hear a motion to adopt the minutes? 2 3 COMMISSIONER BAILEY: I move that we adopt the minutes. 4 COMMISSIONER LEE: I second. 5 CHAIRMAN WROTENBERY: All in favor say "aye". 6 7 COMMISSIONER BAILEY: Aye. 8 COMMISSIONER LEE: Aye. 9 CHAIRMAN WROTENBERY: Aye. 10 * * * 11 12 CHAIRMAN WROTENBERY: Okay, and that brings us to 13 Case Number 12,214. This is the Application of the Oil Conservation Division to amend Division Rule 303 to 14 15 eliminate the requirement of notice to offset operators for 16 downhole commingling applications. 17 And Mr. Carroll, would you like to lay this one out for us? 18 19 MR. CARROLL: Thank you. May it please the Commission, my name is Rand Carroll, appearing on behalf of 20 the Oil Conservation Division. 21 22 As the Commission knows, last month you signed an 23 order adopting new notice requirements in OCD Rule 1207. 24 1207.A (6) deleted the notice to offset operators for 25 downhole commingling applications. The administrative

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procedure found in 303 still required notice to offset 1 operators. 2 So the changes we have proposed -- and I've 3 marked it as OCD Exhibit Number 1 -- as you can see on page 4 3 of Exhibit 1, and it's D (10) (c), was deleted. 5 That's 6 the requirement of notice to offset operators. And in (10) 7 (a) we've just inserted the word "and". So it's (10) (a) and (b), with the deletion of (c). 8 And then on page 4, in 303.F (1), we've just 9 deleted the words "any offset operator or". 10 So it's 11 limited to the interest owners in the spacing unit, and not 12 offset operators. 13 David Catanach, a petroleum engineer and Hearing Examiner within the Division, is currently the head of a 14 15 committee considering extensive changes to 303. We went ahead and made this change regarding notice for the interim 16 17 and did not mess around with any of the rest of 303, 18 because it will be rewritten. 19 So right now, we're just asking that these 20 changes be made so that industry is clear that they don't 21 have to notice offset operators for administrative 22 applications for commingling applications. 23 CHAIRMAN WROTENBERY: Any questions of Mr. 24 Carroll? 25 CHAIRMAN WROTENBERY: No.

COMMISSIONER LEE: (Shakes head) 1 CHAIRMAN WROTENBERY: Mr. Catanach, did you want 2 to make any comments on this? 3 MR. CATANACH: No, I support the rule changes. 4 5 CHAIRMAN WROTENBERY: Is there anybody else in the audience that would like to comment on this proposal? 6 7 MR. KELLAHIN: Madame Chairman, I'm Tom Kellahin 8 of the Santa Fe law firm of Kellahin and Kellahin, 9 appearing on behalf of the New Mexico Oil and Gas 10 Association, and we support the proposed change. 11 There's one more change, perhaps, that Mr. 12 Carroll might want to -- (16) (f), we need to take that out. 13 14 MR. CARROLL: Okay, (16) (f) should be deleted. 15 That's also on page 3 of the exhibit. 16 CHAIRMAN WROTENBERY: So we'll add an "and" after 17 (e), delete the current (f), and then redesignate (g) as (f); is that --18 19 MR. CARROLL: Yeah. 20 CHAIRMAN WROTENBERY: -- what we'll do there? 21 MR. CARROLL: I guess we'd better get Sally 22 cracking. 23 CHAIRMAN WROTENBERY: Any other comments? Okay, 24 we'll move on and take up the next item on our agenda, and 25 in the meantime we can make a quick revision to the Order

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and act on that at the end of the meeting. 1 I also should note that Florene has pointed out 2 that this case -- there was a typo in the docket. 3 This case appeared as 11,214, and it should have been 12,214, so 4 5 we'll just correct that for the record. Okay, then, Mr. Carroll, you'll give that to 6 7 Sally and bring that back or -- Florene, would you mind? 8 Thank you. 9 (Off the record at 9:10 a.m.) 10 (The following proceedings had at 9:43 a.m.) 11 CHAIRMAN WROTENBERY: While Florene is getting 12 the revised order on the Rule 303 amendments, I should just 13 note that we did have one case on the docket, Case 12,161. 14 This was a *de novo* hearing on the Application of Ridgeway Arizona Oil Corporation for a unit agreement in Catron 15 County, New Mexico. 16 17 This case has been continued to the August 12th meeting at the request of the parties. 18 Okay. Mr. Carroll, would you take a look a look at this 19 revision and make sure it does what we wanted it to do? 20 21 I believe, Commissioners, you've had a chance to look at a draft of the Order adopting the amendment to Rule 22 23 303? 24 COMMISSIONER BAILEY: Yes, I have. 25 COMMISSIONER LEE: (Nods)

MR. CARROLL: Yes, it does. 1 CHAIRMAN WROTENBERY: We've made one further 2 3 change in the Order based on the testimony that we got, or the comments that we got here today, and that was in 4 5 paragraph 16 of 303.D, and we deleted what was subparagraph 6 (f) and renumbered the other subparagraphs accordingly. 7 Do I hear a motion to adopt the order amending 8 Rule 303? 9 COMMISSIONER BAILEY: I so move. 10 COMMISSIONER LEE: I second. 11 CHAIRMAN WROTENBERY: Second? All in favor say 12 "aye". 13 COMMISSIONER BAILEY: Aye. COMMISSIONER LEE: 14 Aye. 15 CHAIRMAN WROTENBERY: Aye. Okay, it's done. 16 17 And that was everything that was on our docket 18 today. Any further matters? 19 MS. DAVIDSON: Ridgeway. 20 CHAIRMAN WROTENBERY: I mentioned that Ridgeway 21 had been continued to the August 12th meeting. 22 Okay, then -- Oh, I'm sorry, Mr. Carroll? 23 MR. CARROLL: Yes, Chairman Wrotenbery, on June 24 2nd the Division held a meeting with industry regarding 25 review of our plugging and bonding requirements --

1 CHAIRMAN WROTENBERY: Yes. MR. CARROLL: -- and at that meeting the Division 2 3 said it would make a report to the Commission today, July 15th. That report will be deferred two months to the 4 5 September Commission hearing. 6 CHAIRMAN WROTENBERY: Thank you, Mr. Carroll. 7 I think we did have a good discussion on that 8 particular topic. 9 MR. CARROLL: Oh, yes, we did. 10 CHAIRMAN WROTENBERY: Mr. Carroll is following up, looking at whether we need to propose some changes to 11 12 the statutes or the rules to address bonding and plugging 13 issues. We'll look forward to your report. 14 Okay, thank you very much. 15 We're adjourned. 16 (Thereupon, these proceedings were concluded at 17 9:45 a.m.) 18 * * 19 20 21 22 23 24 25
