## PREHEARING STATEMENT

- Applicant is Navajo Refining Company ("Navajo"). Its attorneys are Losee,

- 2. Protestant is Don L. Benscoter. If he is represented by counsel, counsel's name has not been disclosed.
- 3. Navajo filed an application to convert the Chukka Federal Well No. 2 (formerly the Amoco Production Company Diamond Federal Gas Com No. 1) to a disposal well.

  Protestant objected alleging that he owned the well bore.
  - 4. The issues are:
- a) Whether the Oil Conservation Division ("OCD") has jurisdiction to determine the ownership of the well bore; and
- b) If the OCD has jurisdiction to determine the ownership of the well bore, then is

  Navajo the owner of the well bore or does it have control of the well bore so that it can dispose of
  waste water through the well bore?

- 5. Applicant proposes to call William F. Carr, attorney at law, to testify on the issues presented.
