SUPPLEMENT TO OPERATING AGREEMENT

This Agreement, made and entered into this 24 day of May . 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LHAMMA, the parties desire to subject the above described leases to the terms and conditions of the Operating Agreement.

NOW, THIMEFORE, for end in consideration of the mutual coverants and agreements herein contained, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, it is agreed by and between Brookhaven and El Paso as follows:

- 1. The Operating Agreement above described is hereby amended and supplemented to include Brookhaven's interest in each of the above described leases is committed and subjected to the terms of said Operating Agreement by BRookhaven; subject to approval of title by El Paso's attorneys. Brookhaven shall furnish El Paso with abstracts covering the serial register of New Mexico District Land and Survey Office, and the public records of San Juan County, New Mexico, showing good title in Brookhaven subject only to overriding royalties as specified above. El Paso, within thirty (30) days of receipt of such abstracts, shall either accept or reject each lease. Any lease rejected shall be deleted from this agreement.
- 2. Brookhaven hereby assigns to El Paso the operating rights as provided by said Operating Agreement in and to each of the above described leases and designates El Paso as Operator therefor.
- 3. El Paso, subject to approval of title as above provided, hereby assumes the obligations prescribed by the Operating Agreement as to each of the above described leases; provided El Paso shall



not be oblicated to drill or to pay any rentals on any lease until acceptance thereof.

It, Except as hereby modified and supplemented, the original Operating Agreement shall continue in full force and effect.
