AMENDED ORDER

BY THE DIVISION:

It appearing to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division ("Division") that Order No. R-11301-A dated December 29, 1999, does not correctly state the intended order of the Division.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

(1) Finding Paragraph No. (3) on page 2 of Order No. R-10775-A is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:


" (3) At the time of the hearing Redwolf testified that it would only drill to test the Fruitland Coal formation, and requested that the 40-acre and the 160-acre oil spacing and proration units be dismissed."

(2) Ordering Paragraph No. (4) on page 5 of Order No. R-11301 is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

" (4) The operator of the unit shall commence drilling the well on or before April 1, 2000, and shall thereafter continue drilling the well with due diligence to a depth sufficient to test the Fruitland Coal formation."

(3) The corrections set forth in this order shall be entered retroactively as of December 29, 1999.
