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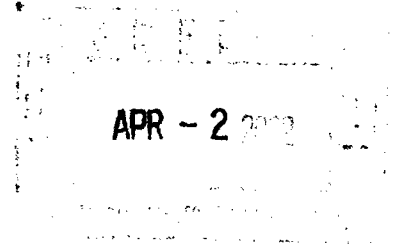

On behalf of Chesapeake Operating, Inc., the operator for Chesapeake Energy Corporation, we are requested a one (1) year extension of the date for actual injection into the referenced West Teas Unit Waterflood Project. If granted, the new injection deadline would be one or before March 18, 2003.
