Case $\frac{1}{334}$: Application of Manzano Oil Corporation for compulsory pooling, Lea County, New Mexico. Applicant seeks an order pooling all mineral interests from the surface to the base of the Strawn formation underlying Lots 12 and 13 of irregular Section 1, Township 16 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, to form a standard 80-acre oil spacing and proration unit for any formations and/or pools developed on 80 acre spacing within that vertical extent, including the Northeast Lovington-Pennsylvanian Pool. The unit is to be dedicated to applicant's Cayuma Well No. 1-A, with a bottom hole location 3175 feet from the south line and 743 feet from the west line (Unit M) of Section 1. Also to be considered will be the cost of re-entering, drilling, and completing the well and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the well, and a charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well. The unit is located approximately 2 miles northeast of Lovington, New Mexico.

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
