

As an heir to the Florence Ring Potts Estate I respectfully seek your help. I have reviewed her 1984 probate in Chaves County, NM, originally filed in Belmont County, OH, and am mailing this letter to the heirs on the attached page. No doubt some of the addresses I have are no longer correct so I include these names and addresses for your corrections, if possible.

There are two people in a title chain I am working on that are lost and I cannot find them. I am writing to you hoping that you may have the solution or may have a lead for me that I can follow.
