APPLICATION OF THE WISER OIL COMPANY FOR COMPULSORY POOLING, LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO.

APPLICATION

No. 12366 The Wiser Oil Company applies for an order pooling all mineral interests from the surface to the base of the Grayburg-San Andres formation underlying the SW4/SW4 of Section 33, Township 16 South, Range 32 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico, and in support thereof, states:

1. Applicant is a working interest owner in the SW4SW4 of Section 33, and has the right to drill a well thereon.

Applicant proposes to drill its Caswell Well No. 1, at an 2. orthodox location 660 feet from the south line and 560 feet from the west line of Section 33, and seeks to dedicate the SWKSWK of Section 33 to the well for all pools or formations developed on 40acre spacing, including the Undesignated Grayburg-Jackson Pool.

3. Applicant has in good faith sought to obtain the voluntary joinder of all other mineral interest owners in the SW4SW4 of Section 33 for the purposes set forth herein.

Although applicant attempted to obtain voluntary 4. agreements from all mineral interest owners to participate in the drilling of the well or to otherwise commit their interests to the well, certain interest owners have failed or refused to join in dedicating their interests. Therefore, applicant seeks an order pooling all mineral interest owners in the SW4SW4 of Section 33, pursuant to NMSA 1978 §70-2-17.

5. The pooling of all mineral interests underlying the SW¼SW¼ of Section 33 will prevent the drilling of unnecessary wells, prevent waste, and protect correlative rights.

WHEREFORE, applicant requests that, after notice and hearing, the Division enter its order:

A. Pooling all mineral interests in the SW¼SW¼ of Section
33, from the surface to the base of the Grayburg-San Andres formation;

B. Designating applicant as operator of the well;

C. Considering the cost of drilling and completing the well, and allocating the cost thereof among the well's working interest owners;

D. Approving actual operating charges and costs charged for supervision, together with a provision adjusting said rates as provided in the COPAS accounting procedure; and

E. Setting a penalty for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well in the event a working interest owner elects not to participate in the well.
