IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF MARBOB ENERGY CORPORATION FOR AN UNORTHODOX WELL LOCATION, EDDY COUNTY, NEW MEXICO.



## **APPLICATION**

MARBOB ENERGY CORPORATION ("Marbob"), through its undersigned attorneys, hereby makes application to the Oil Conservation Division for an order approving an unorthodox well location, and in support of this application states:

- 1. Marbob is a working interest owner in the S/2 of Section 23, Township 26 South, Range 24 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico, and proposes to drill its Primero Federal Well #2 to the Morrow formation, Washington Ranch Morrow South Gas Pool, at an unorthodox gas well location 2116 feet from the South line and 542 feet from the West line (Unit L) of said Section 26.
- 2. The proposed location is necessitated by the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management's ("BLM") requirement that the proposed well be located at the subject location. Marbob originally proposed the subject well at a standard location in the S/2 of Section 26. However, the BLM determined that due to the existence of three "special management areas," sensitive soils, cave karst, and visual, at the standard location, the BLM required that the well be drilled at the location sought by this Application. This location in the Morrow formation is unorthodox because it is governed by the Division's statewide rules which provide for wells on 320-acre spacing units to be located no closer than 660 feet to the nearest section line. Accordingly,

Marbob seeks an exception to Rule 104 C(2)(a) of the General Rules and Regulations of the Oil

Conservation Division to permit the drilling of this well at this unorthodox gas well location.

3. A standard spacing unit comprised of the S/2 of Section 23 should be dedicated to the

well.

4. Approval of this application will afford the interest owners in this spacing unit the

opportunity to produce their just and equitable share of the reserves under the subject unit and will

otherwise be in the best interest of conservation, the prevention of waste and the protection of

correlative rights.

WHEREFORE, Marbob Energy Corporation requests that this application be set for hearing

before an Examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on April 20, 2000, that notice be given as

required by law and the rules of the Division, and that the Division enter its order granting this

application.
