As Santa Fe Snyder Corporation (Santa Fe) should know by now, your well proposal of the referenced date was invalid since Santa Fe did not own an interest in the proposed proration unit consisting of the N/2 of Section 17, inasmuch as Southwestern Energy Production Company (SWN) had not waived the Maintenance of Uniform Interest provision of the Operating Agreement existing between Concho and SWN relative to said acreage. That fact was made clear in a letter from SWN to Concho dated December 14, 1999, with a copy to Santa Fe. However, such waiver was granted to Concho on April 7, 2000.

On March 6, 2000, SWN proposed to Concho a 12,600' Atoka test at a legal location in the center of the NW/4 of Section 17, and on March 9, 2000, a proposal was forwarded to Santa Fe proposing the Baywatch (Maucho) "17" Fed Com #1 as a W/2 proration unit. Since SWN's proposal is the first valid proposal in the Section, SWN plans to proceed ahead and protest your compulsory pooling application.
