3	CHAIRMAN LEMAY: The meeting will come to order.
4	This is the Oil Conservation Commission. Those members
5	present are Commissioner Jami Bailey representing the
6	Commissioner of Public Lands and myself, Bill LeMay,
7	Director of the Oil Conservation Division. Commissioner
8	Weiss chose not to attend.
9	And we are here because of a special meeting that
10	we called about 78 hours ago, I think, a little over three
11	days ago, to consider Case Number 11,666 and Case Number
12	11,677, relating to competitive force pooling applications
13	and request to be operator by KCS Medallion Resources,
14	Inc., formerly InterCoast Oil and Gas Company, and Yates
15	Petroleum Corporation.
16	The reason for this special meeting is the fact
17	that there is a well currently drilling on the prospect,
18	which Medallion is operating under an existing order issued
19	by the Division.

22	parties can either elect to join in the drilling of the
23	well, paying their proportionate share of costs, or be
24	force pooled with a penalty. But that election needs to be
