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STATEMENT OF CASE

APPLICANT

Applicant seeks authorization to drill its proposed M. C. Federal Well No. 6 to test the Devonian formation, Maljamar-Devonian Pool and Wildcat Ellenberger formation at an unorthodox well location 2600 feet from the North line and 660 feet from the East line (Unit H) of Section 21, Township 17 South, Range 32 East, N.M.P.M. The SE/4 NE/4 of said Section 21 will be dedicated to the well in the Devonian formation forming a standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit and the E/2 of said Section 21 will be dedicated to the well in the Ellenberger formation forming a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit. Said units are located approximately 2.5 miles south of Maljamar, New Mexico.


