
Ladies and Gentlemen:

McElvain proposes to dedicate the referenced pooled unit to its Cougar Com "4" Well No. 2 which it proposes to drill to a depth sufficient to test all formations to the base of the Dakota formation, Basin-Dakota Gas Pool, at a standard location in the NW/4 NW/4 of said Section 4.
