Subject: Collection of Surety Bond Covering Navajo Tribal Lease 14-20-600-3531

BK Petroleum, Inc was ordered to submit procedures to plug and abandon the below listed wells by August 17, 1998. The operator/lessee seems to be unable or unwilling to submit plug and abandon procedures for the wells as ordered by the date required. Therefore it is recommended that the surety bond be called upon to plug the wells. Plugging plans have been previously approved for well No. 1W only (January 16, 1998).
