APPLICATION

Pogo Producing Company applies for an order approving a salt water disposal well, and in support thereof, states:

1. Applicant proposes to inject water into the Delaware Mountain Group (Undesignated West Red Tank-Delaware Pool) at depths of 4946-6400 feet subsurface through its Red Tank "30" State Well No. 3, located 1980 feet from the north line and 660 feet from the east line (Unit H) of Section 30, Township 22 South, Range 33 East, N.M.P.M.

2. Injection data includes:

(a) Type of fluid injected: Produced water.

(b) Injection volumes: 1000 BWPD average, and 3000 BWPD maximum.

(c) Injection pressure: 750 psi average, and 900 psi maximum.

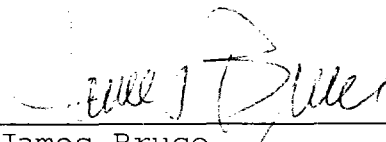
3. A Form C-108 for the proposed injection well is attached hereto as Exhibit A.

4. This application is in the interests of conservation and the prevention of waste.

Applicant seeks approval to use its Red Tank "30" State Well No. 3, located 1980 feet from the north line and 660 feet from the east line (Unit H) of Section 30, Township 22 South, Range 33 East, NMPM to dispose of produced water into the Undesignated West Red Tank-Delaware Pool through the perforated and open hole interval from 4946-6400 feet subsurface. The well is located approximately 21½ miles southwest of Oil Center, New Mexico.
