Application of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division for an order requiring BC Development, LP to plug one well in Lea County, New Mexico

This application has been set for hearing before an Examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on November 2, 2000. Failure to appear at that time and become a party of record will preclude you from challenging the matter at a later date.

Parties appearing in cases are required by Division Rule 1208.B, enclosed, to file a Prehearing Statement three days in advance of the hearing.
