- () 5. The dead men and tie downs have been cut and removed.
- () 6. If a one well lease or last remaining well on lease, the battery and burn pit locations have been levelled and cleared of all junk and equipment.

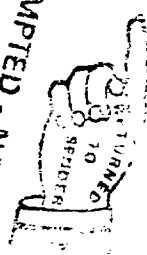
